

## Augusta and Samuel Alberti's Life Together

How and where Augusta and Samuel met is unknown. They were married in Montreal, Canada, in 1870, per family records.

First child, Dora (Dot), was born in 1873, location unknown.

Second child, Olive Carlotta, was born on December 25, 1875, in Plattsburg, New York.

Third child, George, was born on July 4, 1877, location unknown.

Fourth child, Louis, was born on April 23, 1880, in St. Albans, Vermont.

Fifth child, Charles Gabriel, was born May 3, 1884, in New York City, New York.

Sixth child, Joseph, was born in 1886, location unknown.

Seventh child, Edward Isadore, was born in February 1888, in Mt. Clemens, Michigan.

Eighth child, Solomon (Solon), was born December 6, 1889, in Mt. Clemens, Michigan.

Ninth child, Anna (Tutz), was born on September 21, 1891, in Chicago, Illinois.

The family first lived in Chicago at 442 South Paulina, date uncertain, per Samuel's passport.

Lived at 6152 South Kimbark, Chicago, about 1925 per Augusta's passport.

Samuel's life and travels are described in other documents in these files.

Augusta was a supporting wife and mother, raising a large family.

- North face, Augusta Alberti, 1852, 1935

Headstone inscriptions:

- Aspinwall; Fred, 1861 – 1933; Olive, 1875 – 1936, located south of monument
- Edward I. Alberti, 1888 – 1951, located northeast of monument
- Charles G. Alberti, 1884 – 1958, located northwest of monument
- Wolf; Julius, 1872 – 1951; Dora, 1873 – 1941, located southwest of monument
- Sol Wolf, December 3, 1895 – December 13, 1939, Illinois, Pvt 1Cl, 132 Infantry 33 Div, located west of Wolf headstone

Notes:

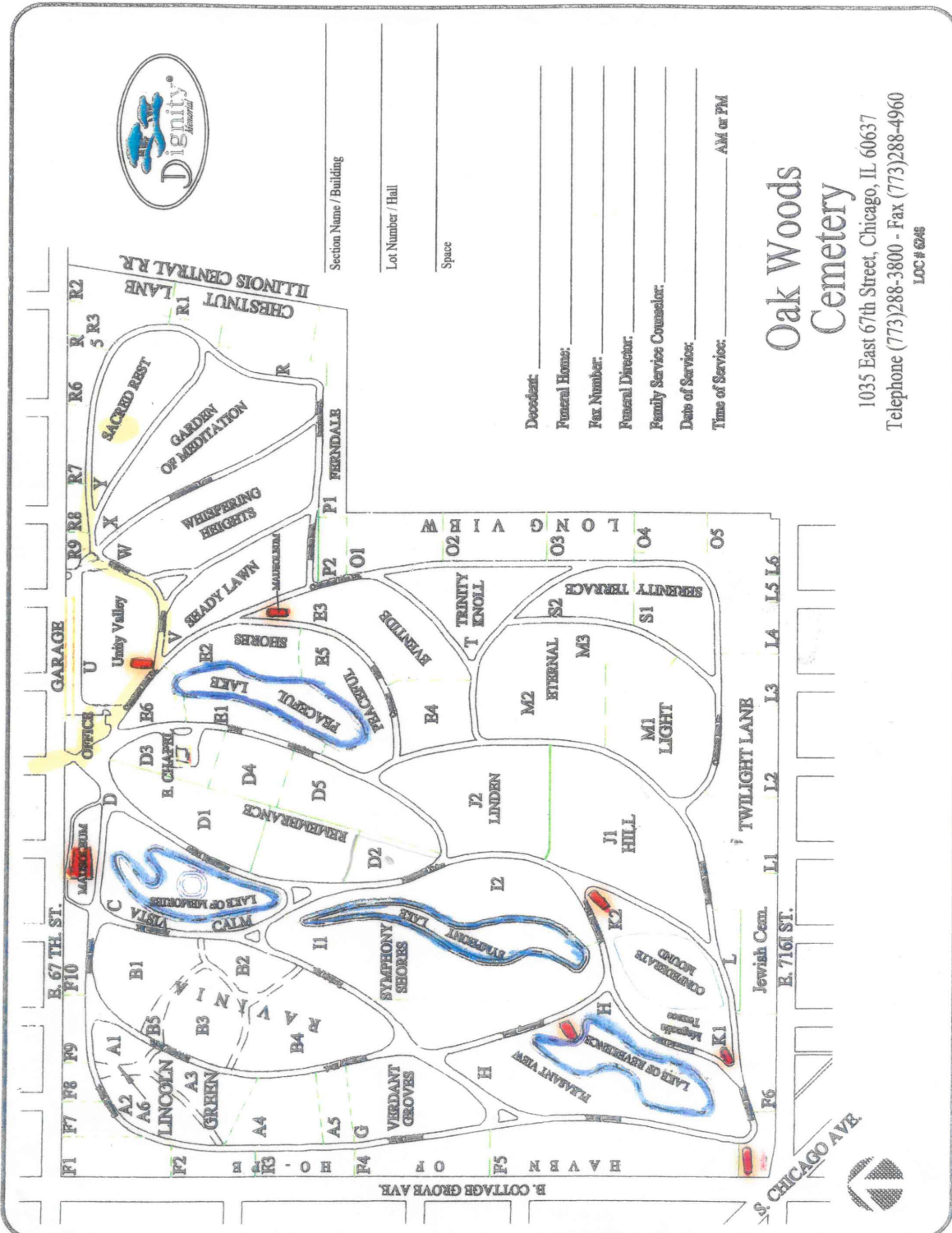
- Masonic symbols are included with Jules and Dora
- Jewish star included with Sol Wolf

Location of monument:

- From the western most point of Section Y, travel east 340 feet east along the road on the north side of Section Y, then walk south 100 feet to the monument.

Additional information:

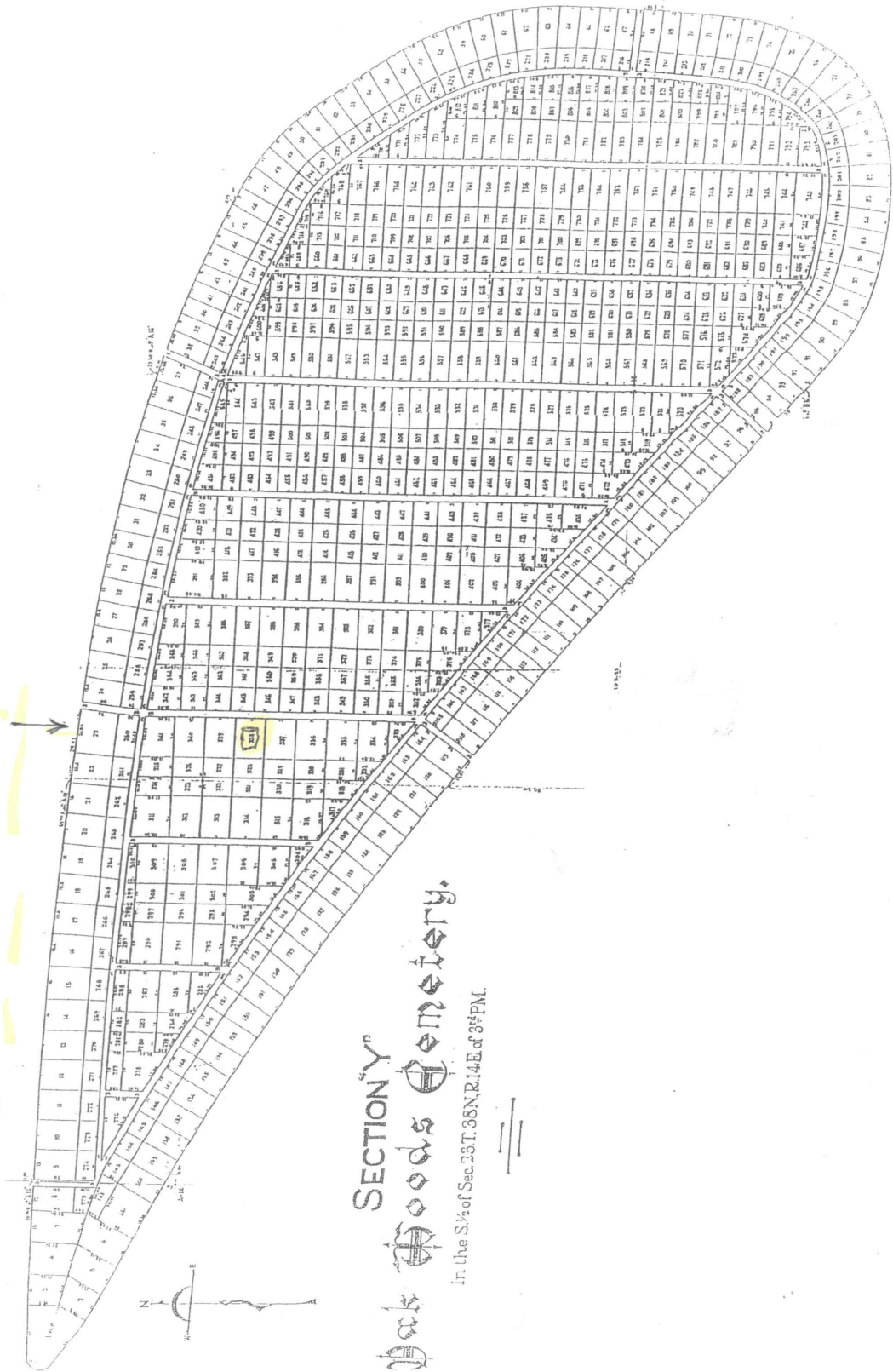
- Samuel and Augusta were Richard Lanyon's great grandparents, his mother's maternal grandfather.
- Fred and Olive Aspinwall were Richard Lanyon's maternal grandparents. Fred and Olive died before Richard was born in 1937.
- Edward Alberti was Olive's brother. His middle name was Isadore. Richard remembers Uncle Ed.
- Charles Alberti was Olive's brother. His middle name was Gabriel. Uncle Charley played the trumpet and taught Richard to play the bugle.
