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INTRODUCTION

From the year in which John and Sarah Lanion arrived in St. Allen Parish, perhaps 1735, until the 1830's, when a relatively large number of descendants of the various Lanyon families began to migrate out of St. Allen Parish, the Lanyon family represented a rather stable and cohesive unit. Therefore, these one hundred years allows for an interesting study of growth of the family.

In the darly 1700's, St. Allen Parish was a relatively unpopulated area with an agrarian economy, located some half dozen miles north of Truro, the seat of the County of Cornwall. John Lanion, raised in the town of Kerris in Paul Parish, perhaps felt the need to relocate because of the expanding mining economy, then prevalent in Paul Parish and the neighboring parishes at the western extremity of Cornwall, near Lands End. While trifling in today's standards, the relocation of some thirty miles distance, from Paul Parish northeasterly to St. Allen Parish, was perhaps a major endeavor.

Similarly, one hundred years later, the economy of St. Allen had become largely dependent on mining. The influx of people and change in life style is perhaps what motivated many of the children of John and Peggy Lanyon to seek new lands upon which to build a life. Also, the 1830's and 40's brought much social legislation to England, a move which was contrary to the Cronishmen's deep set belief of self-reliance and independence.

In 1838, Josiah Lanyon (1816, John), my great grandfather, united in marriage with Esther Brenton in St. Merryn Parish, a few miles north of St. Allen. For the next several years, they lived in London where four children were born to them. Perhaps Josiah, a carpenter, made his living in the construction of homes or buildings. Opportunity seemed more attractive elsewhere, however, because in 1846 this young family is found in Mineral Point, Wisconsin, having settled there following the earlier migration of the families of two of Josiah's older brothers, William and Simon.

Such pioneering and independence is inspiring and has aroused in me a desire to delve into the history of these hardy people. This document serves as a building block in the foundation of information to recreate the lives of these people.

This information on the Lanyons of Saint Allen Parish Cornwall has been compiled during 1979 and 1980. The compilation has two major parts, the first being a series of family unit data sheets and the second, a series of charts to show the descendants of persons and relationships of the family units. Other related information is also included.

The data sheets show the father, mother and children for family units. Where a marriage did not produce children, a data sheet may not have been completed. In a few cases, children born out of wedlock are shown on data sheets, but only in those instances where the offspring was known to have carried the Lanyon name, or where the offspring was known to have lived with the mother and father as a family unit.

The charts show the family units in graphical display which should allow the reader to see the order and relationships of persons and family units much more easily than a study of the family unit data sheets. For the sake of clarity and economy of space, a minimum of information is provided on the charts.

The reader can quickly cross reference the data sheets and charts by the following method. To go from the chart to the data sheets, look for the father of the family unit in question. The name and year of birth or baptism are then used to consult the index to find the page number of the data sheet pertaining to the family unit in question. To go from the data sheet to the charts, simply find the chart code number which is shown as a number within a circle at the upper right corner of the data sheet.

I have started this compilation with John and Sarah Lanion to recognize the fresh start they sought in making their livelihood and raising a family in St. Allen Parish. To the best of my knowledge, I have included all descendants of John and Sarah except those who chose to leave England. In cases where information is fragmentary or unknown, the available information has been included, again for sake of convenience. Such is the case of Charles Scott Lanyon (1845), Henry Lanyon (1781), etc.

In the case of those descendants who migrated to the United States, a subsequent compilation will be produced. Thus, the family of William Lanyon (1810), Josiah Lanyon (1816, John), etc., will be shown in a subsequent document. The nomenclature on the charts in the St. Allen compilation provide for this eventuality.

Several sources of information were used to construct this document. These sources are documented on the individual data sheets. The principal data sources are as follows:

- ** LDS, Salt Lake City, St. Allen Parish Registers microfilm number 226,183. Microfilms were loaned from the Salt Lake City Archives and viewed at the Wilmette, Illinois, branch library.
- ** Chart of the Lanyon family descendants atarting with John Lanion, baptised 8 April, 1711, Paul

Parish, prepared by Emily B. Lueck of Sonoma, California. This chart came into my possession in May, 1979, from Mrs. Lueck.

** A tabulation of the Lanyon descendants, titled "Lanyon Family History" starting with the listing of Henry Lanion, baptised 4 May 1752, St. Allen. This tabulation came into my possession from Esther Lanyon of Chicago, Illinois in August, 1979. This listing was typed by Virginia A. Williams of Marengo, Illinois, using information from various sources, some of which are unknown.

** "The Family Records of the Lanyon Family from 1244 A.D.," collected by Samuel Lanyon, Born 1834, Died 1908. A copy of this manuscript came into my possession in December 1979 from William S. L. Lamparter of Hickory, North Carolina.

As a means of identification, the practice has been adopted of using the name followed by the year of birth or baptism shown in parenthesis. Example: John Lanyon (1782). In a rare case, there is a duplicate of name and year. Identification in this case is achieved by using the person's father's first name following the year. Example: Josiah Lanyon (1816, John).

A final note of explanation regarding the spelling of Lanyon. Prior to the year 1780, the St. Allen Parish Registers carry the spelling of the name "Lanion," whereas, subsequent to 1780, the spelling is consistently "Lanyon." No explanation has been found for this sudden and consistent change.

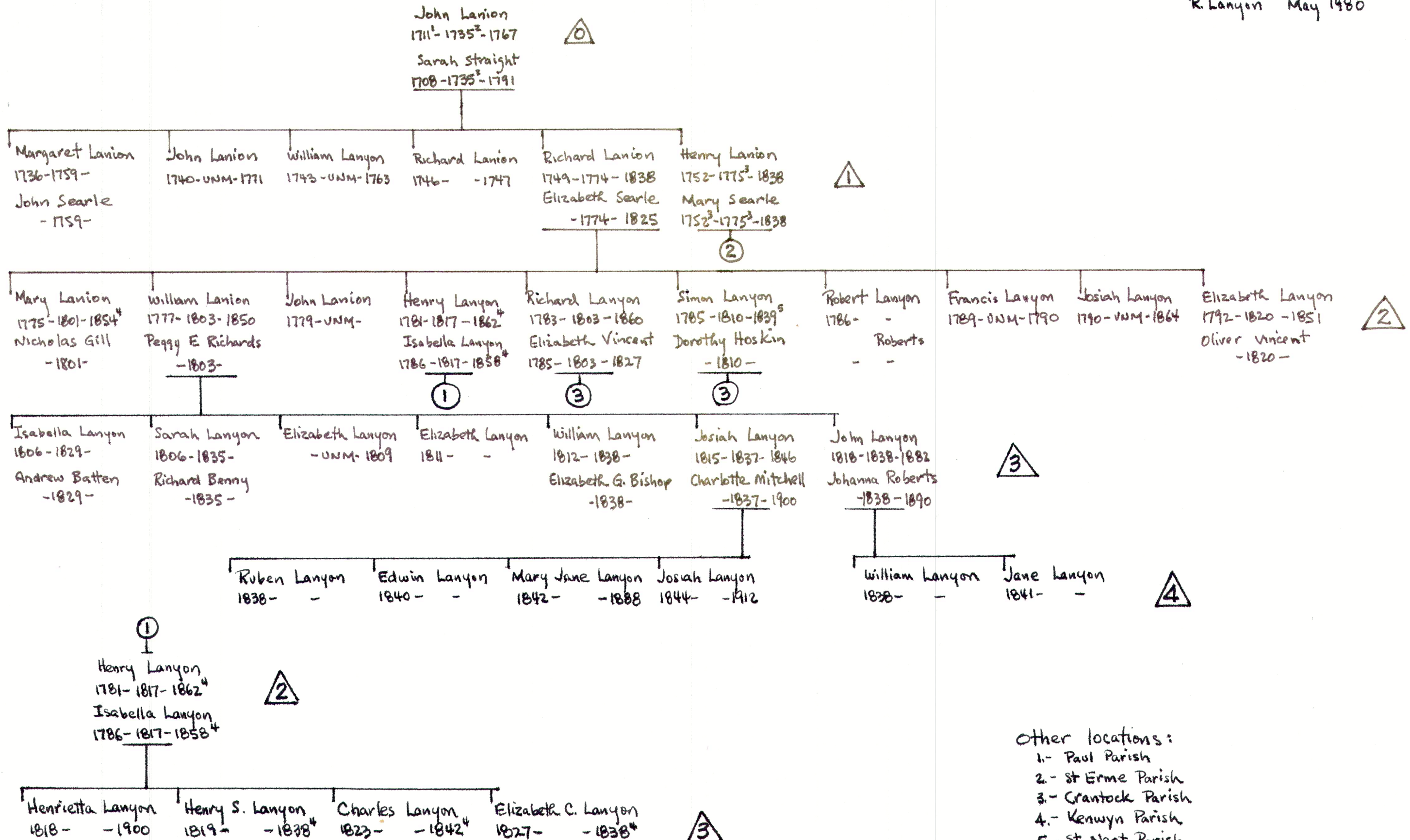
GUIDE FOR USE OF CHARTS

These charts are intended to show the relationship of family units, and not expected to include extensive historical and/or genealogical data.

The basic component on each chart is the family unit. This unit consists of the parents and their children. Each person is listed by name, with three years shown beneath the name. The first year indicates the year of birth or baptism; the second, the year of marriage; and the third, the year of death or burial. These events are assumed to have occurred in or near St. Allen Parish. Numerical superscripts next to the year, refer to footnotes which give the location or approximate location of the event if not in St. Allen.

Where a person's name is listed immediately beneath the name of another person of the opposite sex, this indicates a marriage, or in a few cases, an unwed union producing children. In the case of the latter occurrence, the symbol "OOW" meaning "out-of-wedlock" is used instead of the year of marriage. A dashed line extending beyond the end of a person's name, indicates successive marriages.

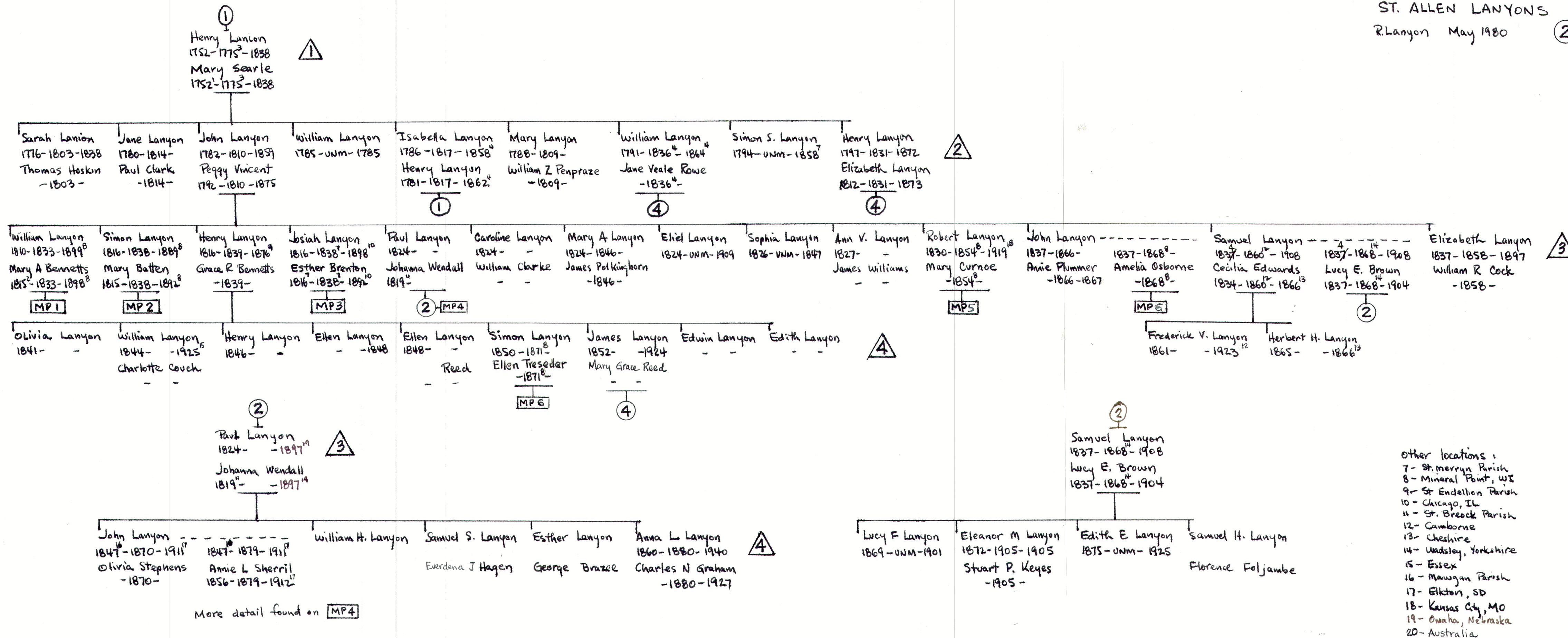
A rectangle beneath the names' of a couple, (e.g. MP 2) indicates that the family unit is continued in another compilation. Where a number appears in a circle, (e.g. 2) either above or below the name, this indicates a continuation from or to the page number indicated in the St. Allen series of charts. A number in a triangle indicates generation succeeding from the first generation shown in the St. Allen series.

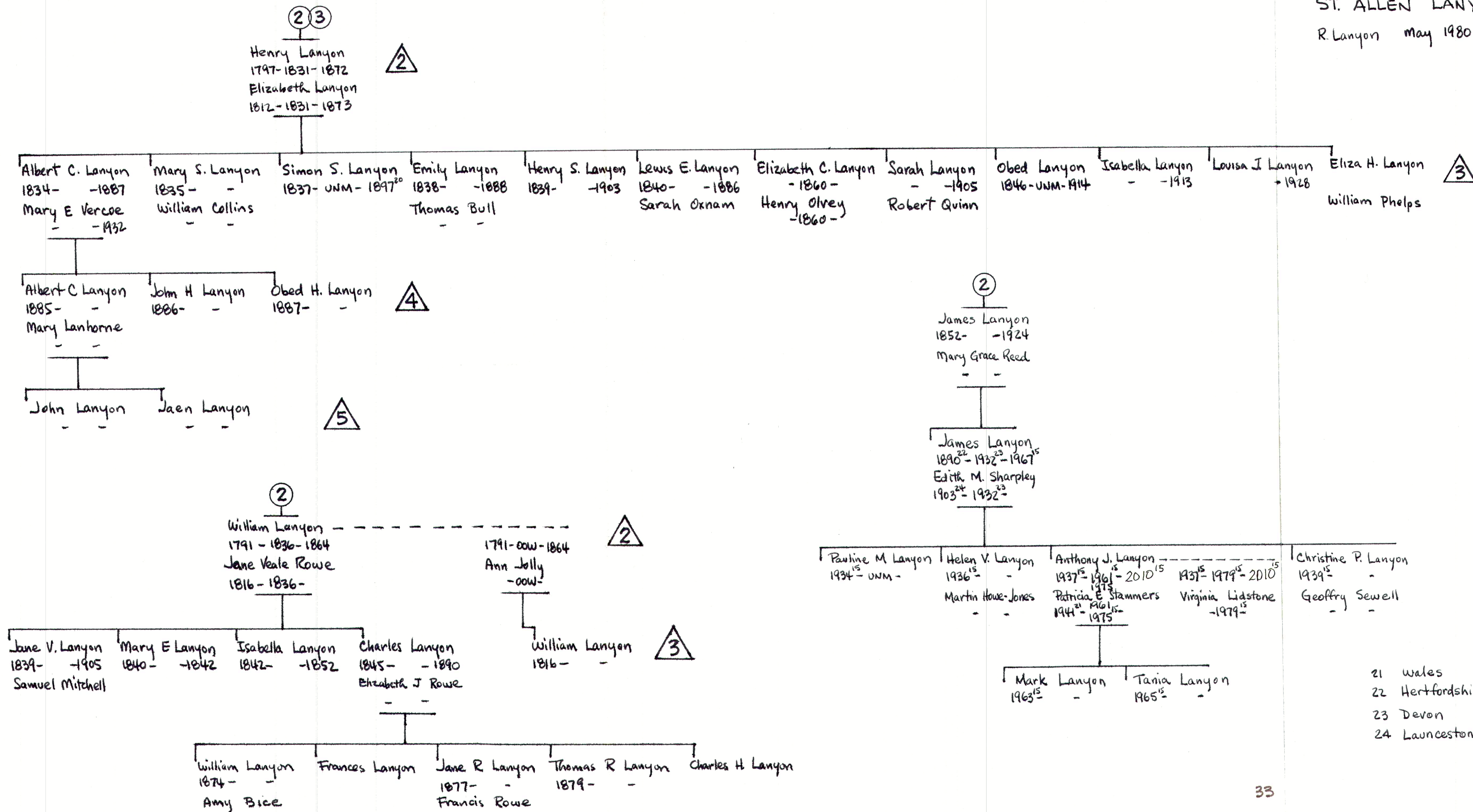

Reference paper: On the marriage of Josiah Lanyon, my great grandfather.

The purpose of this paper is to present certain evidence which leads me to conclude that the above Josiah married one woman named Esther Brenton. This is at variance with information reported by others that Josiah Lanyon married Charlotte Mitchell first, then Esther Brenton second.

The St. Allen, Cornwall, Parish registers (LDS, Salt Lake City, microfilm number 226,183) contain the following entries:

- 1- 4 March 1815, baptised Josiah, son of William and Peggy Lanyon of Churchtown, St. Allen, farmer.
- 2- 26 May 1816, baptised Josiah, son of John & Peggy Lanyon of Zelah, St. Allen, butcher.
- 3- 18 June 1816, baptised Josephus & Josiah, twin sons of Simon & Dorothy Lanyon of Trevalsa, St. Allen, farmer.
- 4- 15 February 1837, married Josiah Lanyon of St. Allen, bachelor, & Charlotte Mitchell of St. Allen, spinster, in the St. Allen Church, by banns.
- 5- 5 August 1842, baptised Mary Jane, daughter of Josiah & Charlotte Lanyon of Zelah, miner.
- 6- 14 July 1846, buried Josiah Lanyon of Zelah, age 32. Note in the register explains this burial and seven others as resulting from a mine disaster.
- 7- 6 May 1900, buried Charlotte Lanyon of Zelah, St. Allen, age 86.

The St. Merryn, Cornwall, Parish registers (LDS, Salt Lake City, microfilm number 226,209) contain the following entry:

- 8- 4 October 1838, married Josiah Lanyon of St. Merryn, bachelor, carpenter, son of John Lanyon, farmer, and Esther Brenton of St. Merryn, spinster, daughter of John Brenton, mason.

The St. Neot, Cornwall, Parish registers (LDS, Salt Lake City, microfilm number 236,530) contain the following entries:

- 9- 28 January 1839, buried Josiah Lanyon of Wenmouth, age 22, died of seizure (register entry number 464).
- 10- 26 December 1839, buried Simon Lanyon of Wenmouth, age 52, father of entry number 464.

The LDS Computer File index (CFI) dated October 1978 contains the following entry:

- 11- 27 July 1845, baptised John Brenton Lanyon, son of Josiah and Esther Lanyon, St. Pancras, Old Church, London.

The Oak Woods Cemetery Association, Chicago, records the following:

- 12- 25 May 1892, buried Esther Lanyon, died 23 January 1892, age 75 years, 4 months, born in England, wife of Josiah.
- 13- 1 July 1898, buried Josiah Lanyon, died 29 June 1898, age 86 years, 6 months, 21 days, born in England.

The 1841 Census of England (LDS, Salt Lake City microfilm number 241,269) was taken on 7 June 1841 in St. Allen Parish. The entries include:

- 14-(place name) Lane: Josiah Lanyon age 25, miner born in Cornwall
Charlotte Lanyon, age 25, "
Ruben Lanyon, age 3, "
Edwin Lanyon, age 1, "

From all of the above, I have concluded that the Josiah Lanyon referred to in items 1, 4, 5, 6, and 14, is the same person. I refer to this person as Josiah Lanyon (1815). His wife is the person Charlotte, referred to in items 4, 5, 7 and 14.

The Josiah Lanyon referred to in items 2, 8, 11 and 13, is the same person, to whom I refer as Josiah Lanyon (1816, John). His wife, Esther, is referred to in items 8, 11, and 12.

The Josiah Lanyon referred to in items 3 and 9, is the same person to whom I refer as Josiah Lanyon (1816, Simon). It is not known if this Josiah was married. However, from the age at death and the lack of a marriage entry on the Parish register, marriage appears unlikely.

Mitchell Therefore, Josiah Lanyon (1816, John), my great grandfather, born to John & Peggy Lanyon: did not marry Charlotte ~~Mitchell~~; did marry Esther Brenton; migrated to the USA; lived in Mineral Point Wisconsin, and Chicago, Illinois; and died in Chicago, Illinois.

This conclusion is not in agreement with information contained in the following references:

- A. Chart of the Lanyon family descendants starting with John Lanion, baptised 8 April, 1711, Paul Parish, prepared by Emily B. Lueck of Sonoma, California. This chart came into my possession in May, 1979, from Mrs. Lueck.
- B. A tabulation of the Lanyon descendants, titled "Lanyon Family History" starting with the listing of Henry Lanion, baptised 4 May 1752, St. Allen. This tabulation came into my possession from Esther Lanyon of Chicago, Illinois in August, 1979. This listing was typed by Virginia A. Williams of Marengo, Illinois, using information from several sources.
- C. "The Family Records of the Lanyon Family from 1244 A.D.", collected by Samuel Lanyon, Born 1834, Died 1908. A copy of this manuscript came into my possession in December 1979 from William S. L. Lamparter of Hickory, North Carolina.

References A and B indicate that Charlotte Mitchell was the first wife and Esther Brenton the second wife of Josiah Lanyon (1816, John). However, these references do not account for the conflicting information in items 5 and 14. Reference C indicates that Charlotte Mitchell was the only wife of Josiah Lanyon (1816, John). However, this reference does not contain information regarding the other two Josiahs. Furthermore, the page relating to the family of John & Peggy Lanyon (page 21) has several unexplained notations in brackets and much missing and/or fragmentary information.

Complete documentation for the above information and other supporting evidence is in the possession of the author. Questions and comments are invited.

Having presented these findings and my conclusion, I would like to express my gratitude to those who encouraged my efforts and provided guidance. I am also grateful to the LDS organization for making such records available, and for the help provided by the staff of the LDS Wilmette branch library.

LANYON COAT OF ARMS

There is no single representation of a "Lanyon Coat of Arms," since the use of arms was intended to be the mark or representation of the individual user. Therefore, each user made slight variations, so that the arms so used would be unique. The arms shown should be viewed as a composite as it is drawn from various sources. Chief among these is the recording in the year 1531 during the Herald's first visitation to Cornwall, England.

The heralds were commissioned by the Crown to go out into the kingdom and record the arms then in use, so that duplication in arms could be accounted for, and, presumably, eliminated. The Lanyon arms so recorded were given by Richard Lanyon of Lanyon (a barton or manor) in Madron Parish, Cornwall, near the city of Penzance. This recording of the arms show only the shield containing a falcon atop a mound enclosed within the castle wall and towers. The waves, representing the sea, were not recorded by the heralds at this time. The recorded version is in the collection of the College of Arms in London.

A full rendering of the arms includes other features. These include: the helmet and crest above the shield, the mantling surrounding the shield, the scroll with motto beneath, and the family name. The crest, on top of the helmet, is a falcon with wings extended, as if ready to rise. The crest is an abbreviation of the arms and is used for identification. Whereas it was used on the helmets of knights in battle and thereby providing ready identification, it is presently used on stationery, signet rings, etc.

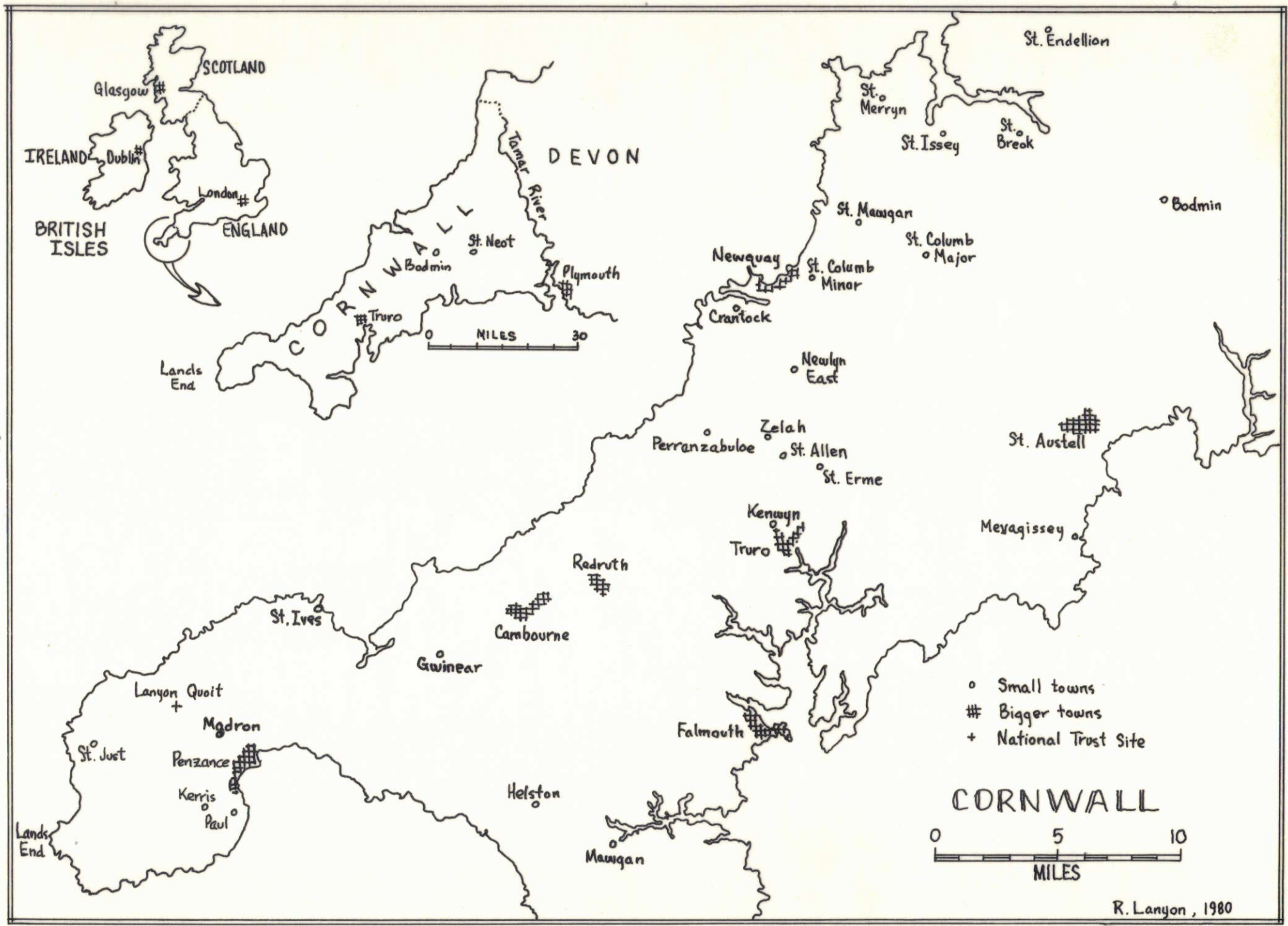
There is today, in Gwinear Parish, about ¹⁵~~ten~~ miles east of Madron Parish, a barton named Lanyon of Gwinear, owned by Anthony James Lanyon, esq. Carved in stone over the main entrance to this manor house, there is a coat of arms which bears many of the features which have been included in the arms rendered herewith. The year 1668 is carved in stone, along with the waves surrounding the castle and the motto. Therefore, this rendering in stone follows that recorded by the heralds by some 137 years, and that lapse in time, no doubt, accounts for the many differences.

The coloration, as specified by that which is registered at the College of Arms, is as follows. The shield is gules (red);

castle towers, argent (silver); mound, vert (green); falcon, proper (i.e., colored as is found in the natural state) except for its beak, eyes, and talons, azure (blue); and the bells and bands about its legs, or (gold). Other than the shield, there is no color specified. It would, however, be so colored as to be harmonious with the shield.

Mottos were not recorded by the heralds and are not registered at the College of Arms. Therefore, there was much freedom in the use of mottos. The motto "Vive ut Vivas," may be literally translated as "Live so that you may be honorably remembered." The spirit of these words has endured the centuries, guiding all Lanyons, regardless of station, to lead honorable lives.

In preparing this brief history and description of the arms, I am much indebted to William S. Lanyon Lamparter, esq., for his valuable information and guidance.

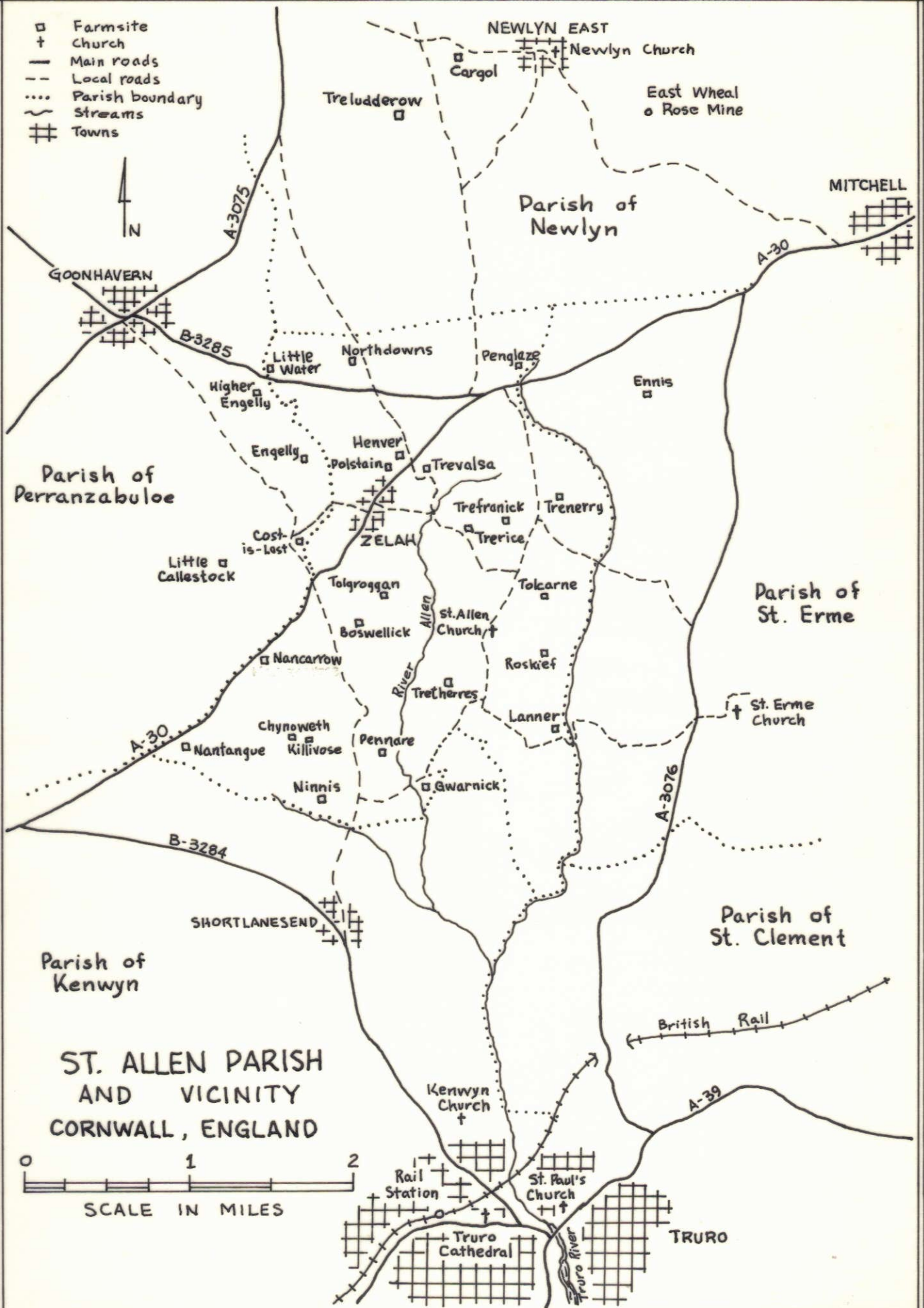


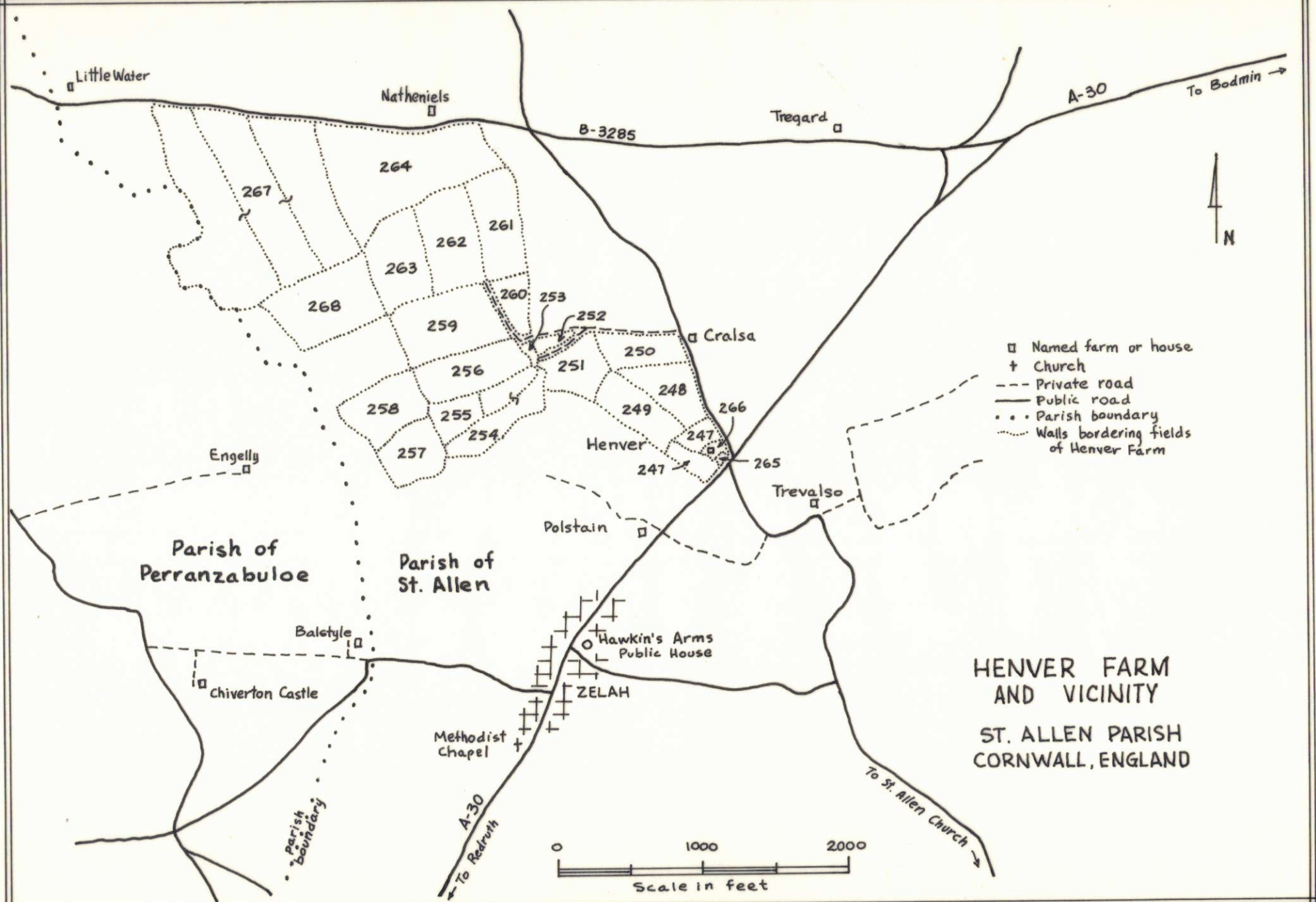
